#### **Twemlows Purchase Completed.**


Our successful share offer raise of £294,000 has enabled us to purchase the 10MW Twemlows solar farm near Whitchurch. Thank you to those who invested, we welcome you all as members of STCE.

This purchase was part of a larger scheme co-ordinated by Community Energy Together (CET) of which STCE is one of 5 members. Overall, the CET sites have added a significant 20% to the UK community owned solar portfolio.

#### £25,000 Now Available Through Our Community Benefit Funds

Our two Twemlows Community Benefit Funds now have an extra £25k available.

£9k of this is available for a wide range of projects within 15 miles of Prees. This fund is managed by Community Resource and has a maximum of £1k per project.

Additionally, £16k is available for carbon saving projects throughout Shropshire and Telford, with a maximum £6k per project. ### **Opportunities to Get Involved in STCE**

STCE are starting to make a significant impact and have plans to do much more. There are several ways you could get involved,

- New Secretary Required, our current Secretary, Fran Hunt, has been part of the working group and committee of STCE for four years and now wishes to hand over the role of Secretary. The main secretarial role involves keeping minutes and ensuring our filing systems are kept up to date. We normally meet once a month, early evening by zoom, though we meet face to face occassionally.

  starting in the Spring.

### Bishop's Castle Heat & Wind project

Further funding for the Bishop's Castle Heat and Wind project has been approved through our Next Generation grant. This will cover ecology surveys and completion of the Landscape and Visual Impact studies. Further funding for the next stage of the heat network study is being sought from the national Community Energy Fund. STCE has been working with the Big Solar Co-op (BSC) for two years now in the pursuit of local rooftop solar schemes. BSC's first site at Kerry Taste & Nutrition, South Shropshire is now generating electricity with a maximum output of 294kW.
