STCE AGM Thurs 27th June 7.30pm (by zoom)

Community Benefit Fund (CBF) Update

We have recently awarded £16,000 from the Twemlows CBF. This is going to,

- 1, Rushbury Village Hall, solar PV panels
- 2, Ditton Priors Village Hall, insulation
- 3, Little Wenlock Village Hall, induction cooker

We have also earmarked some funds for the Orbit, Wellington, details of how it is to be spent to be agreed.

In addition, we have given £9,000 to Community Resource for community projects within 15 miles of Prees (where our 10MW Twemlows solar farm is). If you would like to apply for some of this money contact <u>enquiries@community-resource.org.uk</u>.

We expect to have another funding round in late 2024 or early in 2025.

Further Funding Approved for the Bishop's Castle Heat & Wind Project

Further significant funding for our innovative Bishop's Castle project has been approved from the national Community Energy Fund, managed by the Midlands Net Zero Hub. STCE runs this project in partnership with Lightfoot and support from Sharenergy, Carbon Alternatives and other experienced specialists. More detailed studies are now underway. Case study surveys are being conducted in the town and successful meetings have been held with the Community College and the SpArC leisure centre. We are planning to hold a public meeting late September and to submit a planning application for the wind turbine in October.

Good news from the Big Solar Co-op

Biodiversity at Twemlows

We are currently arranging for soil sampling to be carried out at Twemlows so we can finalise our plans for improving the biodiversity there. A biodiversity working group has been set up. In the first quarter of 2024 there has been a lot of rain and not much sun so the output from our Twemlows solar farm was nearly 25% down on the same quarter last year. However this is a relatively quiet quarter for solar production, so this is only 2.5% of our annual total. We are hoping the sun shines over the summer and this shortfall is soon made up.
