Our Current Share Offer is Extended to Nov 14th, Don't Miss Out..

Our 2025 share offer has now raised over £260k, we are well on our way to our £300k minimum target for this offer and we can celebrate having raised over **Half a Million Pounds!** (including our 2023 raise of £294k)

We've extended the offer period to Nov 14th as we've got an article in the Shropshire magazine that has only just come out. This share offer will enable us to carry out the next phase of securing the Twemlows solar farm, to pay out more from our Community Benefit Fund and increase our membership. New Director Heather Streetly



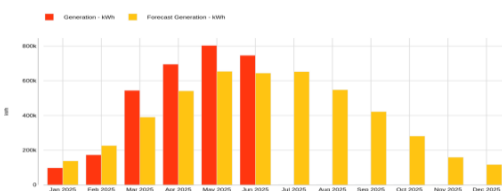
We are delighted to welcome a new co-opted member to the STCE board, Heather Streetly. Heather has worked in Shrewsbury as a hydrogeologist for various environmental consultancies for 30 years until 2025. Having had a successful career in groundwater modelling and water resources management, she was keen to spend less time in front of a computer screen and has been enjoying volunteering for the Shrewsbury Food Hub and working on a 'slow the flow' and rewilding project in South Shropshire with support from the Severn Rivers Trust.

Bishop's Castle Wind Turbine Progress

Whilst we have planning permission for the Bishop's Castle wind turbine we do not currently have a viable business case for the proposed associated heat network. It has therefore been decided to press ahead with the turbine as a stand-alone project in the short term, whilst keeping a heat project as a medium to long term aim. This approach has been accepted at a public meeting and by the town council. A programme of work for the next 18 months is now being drawn up and when that is agreed further funds will be sought to get the project shovel ready, hopefully by 2027.

Record Output from Twemlows

July and August weren't as good as the previous months for solar generation but we have still generated 12.5% more electricity than forecast in the first ten months of 2025 - over 9,000,000 kWh! Our Asset Managers, Bright Renewables, tell us that Twemlows' generation has come top of the leader board for all their sites every month this year!

We are part of the reason that in the past year in the UK wind and solar power has contributed more to the grid than gas power plants. (37.2% as against 29.9% for gas)
